CRITERIA

- Organizations must be youth focused and located in British Columbia, with funds applied to the Lower Fraser Valley youth initiatives.
- Registered charities and foundations must be able to provide a charitable tax-receipt for the full amount of donation.
- Applications for organizations that are not registered charities or foundations, such as community-based programs, will be considered.
